Exchanging Desires

We are born w/out God, with a sin nature in the devil's world of influence. We naturally attach our desires to false means of achieving happiness (+H) based upon our Old Man beliefs. We have to go through a process of transformation to be freed from our Old Man Belief System to embrace a supernatural New Man belief system.

Jesus/disciples have instituted the Eucharist, sang a hymn & gone to the Mt. of Olives. Jesus explains what the night will bring & their denials. He comes to Gethsemane, takes Peter, James & John off to pray. As they go off alone Jesus begins to feel overwhelmed and enters into the final phase of testing in His life.

Vs 37-38	Temptation to Despair	grieved to point of death
Vs 39-41	Test of Desire	let this cup pass from me
Vs 42-45	Triumph of Decision	Your will be done

Tempted to Despair - Dreading the Cross & Death

Vs 37 <u>began</u> to be grieved & distressed – he had not shown his distress until now and until He was in private with His close comrades.

Vs 38 said to them – perilupeo – grieved all around - deeply grieved; my soul to point of death – watch with me – gregoreo – be alert & focused in prayer

- a. Jesus had been explaining His D,B,R & now the time is upon Him
- b. He maintained composure until He was alone with His closest confidants
 - Even He had a small group with whom He shared His pain & struggles
- c. He was anticipating & dreading the suffering about to come to His life.
- d. He refused to allow the pain & sorrow to stop Him from doing God's will

Test of His Desire – His desire cp with GF's desire

- Vs 39 having gone a little farther, He fell on His face & prayed, saying
- Vs 39 1st CC ei + ind. If/true My Father, if it is possible & it is; since it is possible
 - a. 1CC assumes the statement to be true (since it is possible for this cup to pass)
 - b. Jesus knows that nothing is impossible with GF He controls circumstances
 - c. He knew there was a chance to avoid the cross and He was taking His last shot.
- Vs 39 Let this cup pass by Aor. Impv passionate statement of His desire
 - a. Aor Impv here is an impassioned tone making an urgent request to avoid the cross
 - b. Jesus had a normal desire to avoid the pain & suffering that He knew was coming
 - c. He expresses His desire **thelo** but more so seeks GF's desire
- Vs 40-41 returns to find the 3 disciples asleep were you not able to stay alert w me?
 - a. Watch & pray so that you don't enter into temptation (the denials He had predicted)
 - b. Lk 22:45 sleeping from sorrow the news & drama of this day has worn them out and they have decided to escape the pressure of the moment by sleeping

Triumph of Decision - He exchanged the objects of His desire

- Vs 42 2nd prayer: 1st CC ei/ind/ouk since it is not possible for this to pass away
 - a. From 1st prayer to the 2nd Jesus had gotten His answer GF's desire was the cross
 - b. He changes His prayer 1CC since it is not possible for this to pass away

- Vs 42 unless I drink it Let your will be done Aor Impv.
 - a. He recognizes that He cannot avoid the cross, must go through it to do GF's will
 - b. Having accepted reality of GF's will, He passionately affirmed His obedience.
 - c. Aor Impv here is an impassioned tone in agreement with GF's will let's roll!!

Vs 44 prayed the same prayer a third time – He is on board with GF's will

• He changed His passionate desire from avoiding the cross to GF's will.

Exchanging Desires – Examine, Express, Exchange

1. It is normal human behavior to desire pleasant circumstances and to desire to avoid circumstances that cause us pain and suffering – even Jesus had this desire.

Mt 6:13 – lead us not into temptation & deliver us from the evil one. 2Cor 12:7-10 thorn in the flesh – prayed for its removal until he saw it was a gift

2. There is a distinction between normal appropriate desires & sinful desires.

Normal – desires as part of God's design of the human body, soul & spirit Sinful – normal desires attached to wrong objects using wrong methods that have become demands based on believing they are rightfully ours & necessary for +H.

- Normal motivation: pursue pleasure & prevent pain like every other creature
- OSN causes desire to deceive us to believe gratification is our right & necessary

Our Right – desire becomes demand, expectation; Necessary – no +H w/out it

3. God commands that we give up sinful desires in exchange for spiritual desires.

Gal5:16-17 desires of the flesh cp desires of GHS – choose to walk by the Spirit

• Choose to listen & obey GHS – recalls the word & makes application to life Rom 6:12 – don't allow sin to rule you; Rom13:14 no provision/flesh to obey its desires; Eph 4:22 put off OM; Tit 2:12 deny ungodliness & worldly lusts

4. God desires & enables us to surrender our normal human desires to His will

Not my will (thelo – desire, plan) but your will be done – my will surrendered to God's **2Cor 12:7-10** Paul surrendered his desire for health to God's desire that he suffer **Jam 1:2-4** Imagine joyful scenarios that God will bring out of our adversities 1Tim 6:6-10 surrender desire to be rich and choose to be content with basic necessities Mt 19:16-26 Rich young ruler: sell possessions, give to poor, follow me – he was sad

- a. It is not sin to pursue normal human desires w/in the bounds of God's revealed will
- b. Yet, it is not God's desire for us to be focused on or pursue the things of the world.

Col 3:1-2 – seek the things above, focus your mind on things above not on things of earth

- c. His desire is based on true life, love & +H is found only in God not in earthly things.
- d. God desires us to experience the highest & best, not waste our lives on the lesser

5. God blesses us in time/eternity for exchanging normal desires for His desire for us.

Jesus had every right to want his own safety but gave it up for the joy set before Him Mt 6:19-21 don't store treasures on the earth but in heaven – treasure = heart is

6. Examine your desire, express your desire, exchange your desire

Examine Is it sinful? Is it God's will? Is it His highest/best? Express Ask for what you want; wait on God's answer/timing Exchange Surrender your will to His highest – not my will, but your be done

• Detach your heart from the worldly & reattach your heart to the Lord
