### **Impact Missionary Evangelism**

We will begin by examining 10 homiletic elements of Impact Missionary Evangelism from our lesson text

(1 Thess.1:4-9). "knowing, brethren beloved by God, *His* choice of you; for our gospel did not come to you **in** [by means of] word only, but also **in** [by means of] power and **in** [by means of] the Holy Spirit and with full conviction; just as you know what kind of men we proved to be among you for your sake. You also became imitators of us and of the Lord, having received the word in much tribulation with the joy of the Holy Spirit, so that you became an example to all the believers in Macedonia and in Achaia. For the word of the Lord has sounded forth from you, not only in Macedonia and Achaia, but also in every place your faith toward God has gone forth, so that we have no need to say anything. For they themselves report about us what kind of a reception we had with you, and how you turned to God from idols to serve a living and true God,
