The Book of 3rd John (03) (A Sick Soul)

(3 John 2) "Beloved, I pray that in all respects you may prosper and <u>be in good health, just as your soul</u> prospers."

John talks about a **good healthy soul** in 3 John 2. We will study this doctrinal concept next week. But this lesson is taken from Ps.41:4 and the SICK SOUL of a Church Age Believer (CAB).

(Ps.41:4) "<u>As for me</u>, I said, 'O Lord be gracious (chanan / chen) [Show Grace] to me; **heal** (raphe / kal impv) [Command] my **soul** (nephesh), <u>for I have sinned against You</u>." (David's Plea)

- David used the phrase, as for me, to show that he had fallen from the status of Beatitude healthy soul to a Sick Soul (Ps.41:1).
- David confesses that he has fallen from the sphere of unmerited favor of God because of personal sin (Ps.38:3).
- David has a Sick Soul and in need of God's grace and mercy for healing back to good spiritual health.
- David's path to recovery to a healthy soul begins with confession of his personal sin.
 (Ps.32:1) "How blessed is he whose transgression is forgiven, whose sin is covered?"

(Ps.51:4) "Against You, You only, I have sinned and done what is evil in Your sight, so that You are justified when You speak and blameless when you judge." (Luke 15:21; **1 John 1:9**)

(1 Pet.2:24) "And He Himself **bore our sins** in His body on the cross, so that we might die to sin and live to righteousness; <u>for by His wounds you were healed</u>." (Isa.53:5)

This lesson will study four signs of a SICK SOUL and recovery to a state of good health.

1. One sign of a sick soul in recovery is after confession of sin and returned to assembly bible study, he is "dull of hearing." (Heb.5:11-14)

He is struggling with attention, distracted by other interests and inconsistent in his attendance of bible study (Heb.5:11).

(Heb.5:12b) "You have **need again** for someone to teach you the elementary principles of the oracles of God, and you have come to **need milk** and not solid food."

A healthy soul gets excited about cycling the word of God (1 Pet.2:2; Luke 24:32; 2 Tim.3:16-17).

2. A sickly soul is easily deceived by the craftiness of satan and led astray from the simplicity and purity of devotion to Christ (2 Cor.11:3) [Eve].

Peter was another example of this doctrinal principle (Matt.16:21-23; Luke 22:31-32).

Paul warns the church against **"falling away from the faith, paying attention to deceitful spirits and doctrines of demons."** (1 Tim.4:1; 2 Pet.2:1-2; 2 Tim.2:18; Gal.5:4)

Paul's encouragement to Timothy about having a Healthy soul:

(1 Tim.4:16) "Pay close attention to yourself and to your teaching; persevere in these things, for as you do this you will ensure salvation both for yourself and for those who hear you."

3. A sick soul can be seen in a Church Age Believer's (CAB) life who no longer endures healthy doctrines because of "itching ears syndrome."

(2 Tim.4:3-4) "For the time will come when <u>they will not endure sound (healthy) doctrine</u>; but wanting to have their **ears tickled**, they will <u>accumulate for themselves teachers in accordance to their own desires</u>, and will **turn away their ears from the truth** and will turn aside to myths." (1 Tim.3:7-8)

(Heb.10:25) "**Not forsaking our own assembling together**, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another; and <u>all the more as you see the day drawing near</u>."

4. A sick soul can wander away from the faith over the frantic search for the Details of Life (DOLs).

(1 Tim.6:10) "For the love of money is a root of all sort of evil, and <u>some by longing</u> for it have **wandered away from the faith** and <u>pierced themselves with many grief's.</u>"

Lot and his wife would be one example (Luke 17:32; Gen.19:12-26).

(2 Tim.1:13-14) "**Retain the standard of sound (healthy) words** which you have heard from me, in the faith and love which are in Christ Jesus. Guard, through the Holy Spirit who dwells in us<u>, the treasure</u> which has been entrusted to you." (Titus 1:9)
