## **Lesson: ESTABLISHED IN THE FAITH**

Paul has been struggling with what to teach these three churches of the Lycus Valley of Asia Minor (Col.1:24-29; 4:13).

Paul is concerned with false teaching inside these churches that was attacking grace and growth (2 Pet.3:18; Col.2:1-5).

He was afraid that they would become spiritually delusional by false doctrines to the truth of God's word. "I say this in order that no one may delude you with persuasive argument." (2:4)

This lesson will study **FOUR** aspects of Established in the Faith.

 In Col.2:6, Paul established the doctrine of Faith Cycle Drill as an essential doctrine of the CWL (Christian Way of Life). "As you therefore have received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk in Him."

The Greek word for **walk is peripateo** used as a standing command (*p.a.impv.2pl*). Draw a circle on our paper and put a dot in the center.

The doctrine of inhale and exhale is important to **Faith Cycle Drill** (2 **Tim.3:16-17** / **inspired or Godbreathed**).

## Faith Cycle Drill (clockwise)

Hearing (Rom. 10:17

Completing (James 2:22)

Heb.11:1

Believing (Heb.4:2)

Applying (2 Cor.5:7)

All church age doctrine flow in and out of the Christian life by this Faith Cycle Drill.

2. In **Col.2:7**, Paul established three basic doctrines essential to the CWL. Paul's use of the Greek language sets these three doctrines in order and purpose of spiritual growth development.

1st basic doctrine: "Having been rooted (rhizoo/ perf p. ptc.nplm/ in Him)" - Salvation

2<sup>nd</sup> basic doctrine: "Being **built up (epoikodomeo**/ p.p.ptc.nplm/ in Him)" - Spiritual Growth

3<sup>rd</sup> basic doctrine: "Being **established** in the faith (bebaioo/ p.p.ptc.nplm/ in Him)" – Spiritual Ministry

Notice: **They are all** participles (ptc/ verbal adjective) and passive voices (p) and nominative plural masculine. Participles work off the main verb which is **walk in 2:6.** 

Notice: First ptc is perfect tense and the other two are present tenses.

- Perfect tense is completed in the past with completed results in the present.
- Present tense is continuous action.
- 3. All CAB (church age believers) are firmly rooted in Christ the moment they believe the gospel of 1 Cor.15:3-4; Rom.1:16; Eph.2:8-9.

Col.2:7 - Rooted in Christ (**perfect passive** ptc. nplm) is the result of God's grace the moment a person believes the gospel.

In the Parable of the Sower (Matt.13:1-17), the soil of rocky places didn't allow the seed to take root (13:5-6/ explained in 13:20-21). The seed required good soil (PV at hearing and understanding and believing to become ROOTED/ Matt.13:23)

**Rooted in Christ** is just one of many examples of grace eternal security (sealed in Christ/Eph.1:13-14; 4:30; John 10:28-30).

4. Paul closed Col.2:7 with this statement, "Just as you were instructed (didasko/a.p.ind2pl)."

Remember that just saying, "I don't understand, doesn't mean I can't understand." (John 16:29-33)

Natural man cannot understand any spiritual matters except the gospel (1 Cor.2:10-3:3).

**Spiritual man** can understand everything under the ministry of indwelling Holy Spirit (**John 14:26**/ divine revelation).
